

Specialist Hub provision consent

- I understand that the rainbow class will have a high staff: child ratio and my child will work with all staff in this class
- I understand the timings of the school day are 8.45am - 3.00pm
- I understand that the lead practitioners are Mrs Whitehouse (class teacher), Miss Hartill and Mrs Harris and Miss Skidmore oversees the rainbow class
- I understand that the rainbow class will support my child's speech, language and communication needs and teaching methods will be used to support these needs, such as now/next boards, visuals, work station and task system. This is designed so negative behaviours due to frustration are minimised
- I understand that my child will be following the Orchard Curriculum for their teaching and learning
- I understand that staff have had specialist training in areas such as ALD's, Team Teach and intensive interaction
- I understand that planning will be personalised to my child's needs
- I understand that my child will work 1 - 1 and in small groups
- I understand that the mainstream classroom environment is too over stimulating, noisy and busy for my child which could heighten their anxieties
- I understand that the school's ultimate aim is to integrate my child back into the mainstream classroom when/if ready. This could be for $\frac{1}{2}$ day, specific sessions such as trim trail, music etc. This will be discussed with parents regularly across the academic year
