## Exciting building project to replace two classrooms and changes to movement around the school site

Dear families,

We are pleased to inform you that we are now able to move forward with an exciting building project to replace the two classrooms at the Year 2 end of the school. This project will involve the demolition of the existing structure and the construction of two new, modern classrooms.

### What Is Happening?

The current building is in desperate need of replacement to ensure a safe, comfortable, and inspiring learning environment for our children. The entire project is expected to take at least 20 weeks to complete, which is why it is essential to begin over the Easter holiday to minimise disruption to the children's education. These developments are part of our ongoing commitment to providing high-quality facilities that support the learning, safety, and wellbeing of all our children.

### Changes Around the School

During the construction period, there will be some temporary adjustments to how children, staff and visitors move around the school. These measures are essential to ensure everyone's safety while the work is underway.

Key changes include:

- No access to Moat Farm Junior School from the back pathway.
- No access to the rear of the school building via staff car park and usual gates.
- Additional of new boundary fencing to ensure no access into the work site area.
