Sandwell Holiday Activities & Food

What is HAF?

The Holiday Activities and Food (HAF) programme is funded by the Department for Education and provides free holiday activities for children aged 5–16 who receive benefits-related free school meals. Sessions run during Easter, summer and winter holidays and include a hot meal.

HAF helps children stay active, healthy and supported, while also connecting families to local services.

What can my child access?

Eligible children in Sandwell can access:

- 4 days of free activities at Easter and winter
- 16 days of free activities in summer

All activity sessions last at least 4 hours and includes activities, food, and learning about healthy lifestyles. Booking is required in advance.

Who is eligible?

Children aged 5–16 (or 4 if in full-time reception) who:

- Receive benefits-related free school meals
- Attend a Sandwell school

Why take part?

- Completely FREE for eligible families
- Safe, fun and supervised environments
- Helps with childcare during holidays
- Supports your child's health, wellbeing and learning

How to get involved
